

PENN HILLS / PLUM SENIOR SOFTBALL RULES

ASA rules apply unless otherwise noted

THE PLAYING FIELD

1. 65 foot bases.
2. Pitcher's mound distance is 46 or 50 feet. Mark two lines. Plum will have a pitching rubber at 50 feet. A mark will be made at 46 feet if necessary.
3. From the back tip of home plate to the center of 2nd base is 91 feet 11 inches.
4. Use a double bag at 1st.

NUMBER OF INNINGS

1. A game consists of 7 innings unless terminated by the umpire.
2. The 15-run rule will be in effect after 5 complete innings.
3. Any game that does not reach regulation length shall be resumed from the exact point of curtailment. Mark pertinent details in your scorebook. A 5 inning game (darkness, rain, etc.) is a legal game.

PITCHING

1. There will be no INTENTIONAL walks. Any infraction will result in the removal of the pitcher from the pitching position for the remainder of the game. This is a judgment call by the umpire. Make the umpire aware of this rule during pre-game discussion.
2. Once a pitcher starts at 46 or 50 feet, they must stay there. A new pitcher has her choice.

BATTING

1. Continuous batting order.
2. Any player who throws her equipment in anger can be removed from the game by the umpire.

BASERUNNING

1. A base runner cannot leave the base until the ball is hit. Any runner off the base prior to the ball being hit will be called out.
2. Base runners SHOULD slide at any base in which a play is being made, except 1st base.
3. A runner deliberately crashing into a defensive player holding the ball will be called out and the ball will be declared dead. If the act is determined to be FLAGRANT, the offender will be ejected.

EQUIPMENT

1. Batters and base runners must wear a helmet with a chin strap and for Penn Hills players a face mask.
2. A player wearing the batting helmet improperly or removing it intentionally during a live ball play, as judged so by the umpire, will be declared out and the ball remains alive.

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EQUIPMENT (cont'd)

3. Catchers must wear a batting helmet with a face mask or a catcher's helmet. Chest protector and shin guards are optional.
4. No metal spikes.
5. Only ASA approved bats will be allowed.

GAME RULES

1. All members of teams in the league **MUST** play at least two consecutive innings in the field. Any manager not abiding by the rule shall automatically **FORFEIT** the game, and be subject to disciplinary action by the board.
2. All games will be played at the scheduled time except for inclement weather or unplayable field conditions. Games have been rescheduled in the past due to a **MAJOR** school event. Do not attempt to do so without the league representative's permission.
3. The league will reschedule rain outs as soon as possible.
4. To avoid forfeiting a game, a manager may "bring up" a player from a lower league to be used for a game provided:
 - a. Permission is obtained from the lower league manager.
 - b. The team cannot field ten players. A team may play with nine.
 - c. The player brought up must bat last, can play any position on the field vacated by the team's regular player, except pitcher or be the EP.
 - d. All call-ups must wear their own team uniform.
 - e. If a team player arrives after the start of the game, the call-up player should play two innings and then be replaced by the regular team member. **DO NOT RESUBSTITUTE THE CALL-UP PLAYER FOR A REGULAR PLAYER LATER IN THE GAME!**
5. A team will forfeit the game if they cannot field a team within 15 minutes of their scheduled start time.
6. During a game, only managers, coaches, scorekeepers and players are permitted on the field or in the dugout area. Players not on the field or on deck **MUST** remain in the dugout. The respective team managers are **RESPONSIBLE** for their players and coaches. "Managers. Keep your coaches, players and fans under control!"
7. **CLEAN UP YOUR DUGOUT AFTER THE GAME!!!**
8. **PLUM FIELDS ONLY** – The start time for each league game on weeknights is 6:15pm. On lighted fields, no new inning of the 1st game may start after 8:15pm. Teams for the 2nd game should be available to start play by 8:00pm or as soon as the umpire is ready. No between game batting and/or fielding practice is permitted after 8:00pm. The 2nd game shall start no later than 8:45pm with no new inning starting after 11:00pm.
9. **PENN HILLS FIELDS ONLY** – The start time for each league game on weeknights will vary depending on the field being used.
10. The **INFIELD FLY RULE** is utilized. Educate your players on this rule.

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GAME RULES (cont'd)

11. You cannot appeal or protest an umpire's judgment call. Do everything to avoid a protest. If you do protest, you must notify the umpire before any succeeding play begins. Any protest for any reason must be submitted within 24 hours to the league representative or President of the league representing the field on which the protest occurred. The Board of Directors of that league shall hear and resolve any protest. If the protest is allowed, the game shall resume from the exact point at which the infraction occurred.

HOME TEAM DUTIES

1. The home team is responsible for the field preparation except in the case of inclement weather when both teams are expected to help get the field ready for play. Show up early on bad weather days. The home team is responsible for physically checking the field before cancelling any game due to inclement weather. Notify the league representative before cancelling any game.
2. The home team is responsible for getting and returning bases and other items used for field preparation.
3. The home team is responsible for levelling off the dirt in the batter's box, pitcher's mound and around the bases after each game (Plum fields only).
4. The home team will supply one new ball and one decent used ball for every home game. If more than two balls are needed, both managers will select decent balls from their used game balls.
5. The home team will reside on the 1st base sideline dugout and the visitors on the 3rd base sideline dugout.
6. Teams may practice at these designated times prior to the start of each 6:00pm game. The home team may take the field prior to 5:30pm at which time the visitors take the field until 5:55pm. The last five minutes are reserved for the managers and umpire to go over ground rules (Plum fields only).
7. Umpire fees will be handled by the PBSA and Umpire Group for Plum fields.
8. The WINNING TEAM MANAGER is *RESPONSIBLE* for calling their league representative after the game.

REGULAR SEASON TIE-BREAKING RULES (Penn Hills ONLY)

1. 1st – head to head play.
2. 2nd – least number of runs allowed in all games played during the regular season
3. 3rd – least number of runs allowed in the games played head to head
4. 4th – flip of a coin
